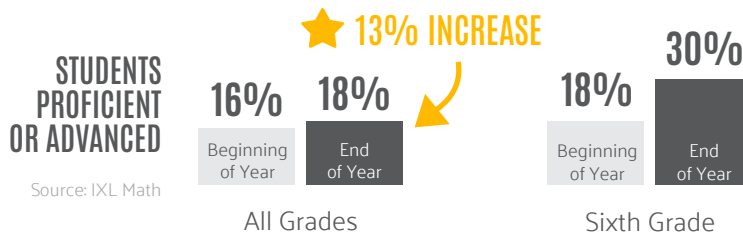

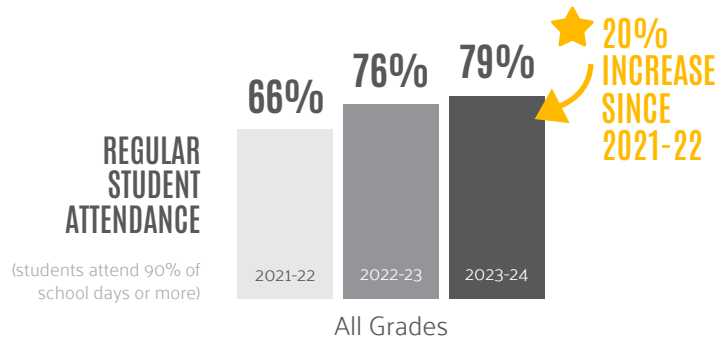

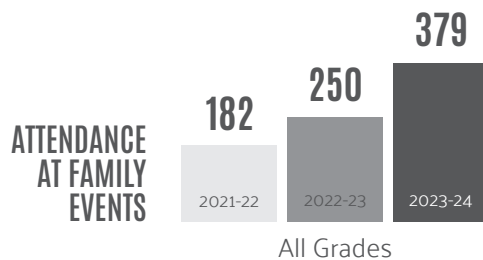

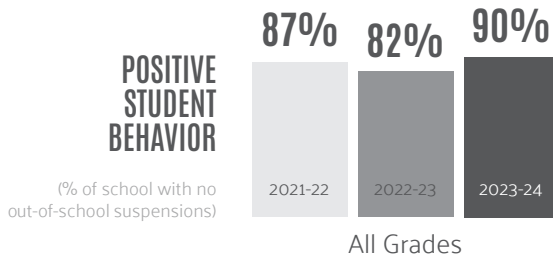
SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL LEARNING ACTIVITIES IMPROVE SCHOOL CLIMATE AND CULTURE

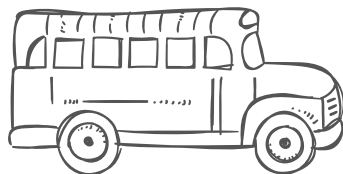
