Ramos had a record number of Kindergarten students register on time. In partnership with KidsPeace, Pinebrook Family Answers and Vision to Learn, Ramos held a Kindergarten Registration Event and Resource Fair to prepare incoming Kindergarten families for the first day of school. This event not only helped meet the school's registration goal of 100 students, but it exceeded the goal. The leadership team rolled out school-wide Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS), that decreased disciplinary incidents by 77%. Students earn points through Class Dojo for demonstrating skills tied to district-wide monthly Social Emotional Learning themes. The top three students/classrooms were honored and the top earning student was awarded the "You are the Light" award at the Allentown School District ceremony.
